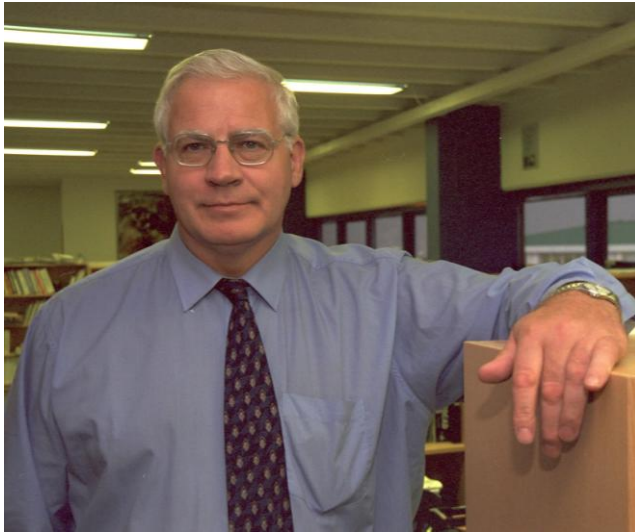

Eng. Jon Hjaltlin Magnusson is a "part time" Conference Manager at the Keilir Conference Centre responsible for developing interesting international conferences like the „Eyjafjallajökull and Aviation“ conference in September 2011, etc.

Jon founded his company Metaltech in Reykjavik in 1987 and has since then been working in product development and services for the aluminium industry with new innovative technologies. Jon is also a manager of own company; Arctus Metals Ltd., specialised in development of a new aluminium reduction technology.

In December 2002, Jon was declared *Entrepreneur of the Year* by the Icelandic Press and Channel Two television in recognition of his success in bringing new international business to METALTECH.

In February 2003, Jon was selected *Innovator of the Year* by the Export Council of Iceland and the Science and Research Foundation for developing over 30 innovative products and systems for the aluminium industry.

In January 2003, Jon was installed as an Honorary Professor at the Southern Institute of Metallurgy (JUST), Ganzhou Jiangxi, People's Republic of China. The citation refers to his "*outstanding achievements in the aluminium industry and great efforts in establishing co-operation between the Southern Institute of Metallurgy and universities in Iceland*".

Jon has a M.Sc. in Electronic Engineering from the Technical University of Lund in Sweden.

Jon was President of the Icelandic Handball Federation 1984-92 and was successful in 1988 to bring the A-world championship for men in handball organized in Iceland in 1995. He was a member of the Icelandic Olympic Committee 1984-92 and Icelandic Team Leader in the B-World Handball Championship in France (Gold Medal) and in the Olympics 1984 and 1988, Jon Played 54 international games in handball for Iceland including the World Championship 1970 and Olympics in Munchen 1972.
