Thorgeir Pálsson became Professor of Air Navigation Technology at Reykjavik University in May 2010 when he stepped down as Chief Executive of Isavia after three years of service. Prior to this engagement he had been the Director General of Civil Aviation in Iceland, a position that he assumed in 1992 after having served as Professor of Systems Engineering in the Engineering Department of the University of Iceland.

Dr. Pálsson has been professionally active in all fields of aviation including the development of navigation systems, provision of air navigation services to international civil aviation in the North Atlantic and the operation and improvement of airports. As Director General of Aviation he held responsibility for the safety regulation of civil aviation in Iceland including airworthiness of aircraft, air transport operations and certification of air crew members.

Dr. Pálsson earned a doctoral degree from MIT's Department of Aeronautics and Astronautics in 1971 with specialization in the design of guidance and flight control systems.
