Dr. Gordeev Evgenii Iljich was born in Orenburg (Russia), on November 25th, 1948. He was graduate in Physics in Moscow State University, Physical Faculty in 1972, doctor of Physics and Mathematics (Russian candidate of Physics and Mathematics) from 1980. Since 1972 till 1979 he was working at the Institute of Volcanology Russian Academy of Sciences as researcher and since 1979 as head of research laboratory, since 1980 up to 2004 at Kamchatkian Experimental and Methodical Seismological Department, Geophysical Service, Russian Academy of Sciences as director. In 1996 he held the course "Surface seismic waves" in Catania University, Italy.

In 1997 he won the competition in NATO-CNR grant and was staying four months in University of Camerino, Italy. The research during NATO-CNR fellowship has been focused on: 1) the seismological aspects related to the active tectonic structures of the Central Apennine, 2) the Camerino seismic network and 3) on problems related to the source dynamics of seismo-volcanic events.

At March 1998 he received the degree High Level Doctor (Russian doctor of Physics and Mathematics) on basic topics "The originality of the seismic signals on active volcanoes". He has focused research activity on the study of volcanic seismology, ocean microseism, prediction of earthquakes, high-frequency seismic noise and seismicity in subduction zones. In 2004 he was elected as Director of Institute of Volcanology and Seismology.

In 2008 he was elected Academician of Russian Academy of Sciences.
