Reynir Sigurdsson earned his B.S. and M.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from University of Iceland and the Technical University of Denmark in 1988 and 1990 respectively and a diploma in Business and Administration from the University of Iceland in 2000.

His present position is a Director, ANS & Aerodromes at Icelandic Civil Aviation Administration, where he is responsible for certification and safety oversight of Air Navigation services, Aerodromes and Security in Iceland. In this capacity he is also responsible for the setup of the National Supervisory Authority (NSA) where he is the acting head of NSA. Before joining ICAA in 2008 he worked for Reykjavik Fiber Networks where he established and was in charge of a project office for a major Fibre To The Home rollout project. In 2001-2005 he was working as a Senior CNS/ATM consultant for Integra Consult in Denmark working on projects in Scandinavia, Europe and Africa. In 2000-2001 he worked for a software company Kogun Ltd. as a project manager and consultant on projects developing military and civil systems. Prior to that, 1991-2000 he worked for the Icelandic Civil Aviation Administration as a project manager and software engineer working on Flight Data Processing Systems and maintenance of operational systems in the Reykjavik Oceanic Area Control Centre.

Mr. Sigurdsson was a board member of the Electrical branch in the Engineering Association in Iceland and a board member for the Project Management Association of Iceland where he was chairman 2009-2010.
